



Due to continued visitor restrictions put in place by the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) and the desire of CMSS to keep residents and staff safe we have put the following procedures in place.

***PLEASE NOTE WE WILL ONLY BE ABLE TO ACCOMMODATE VISITS
THAT HAVE BEEN SCHEDULED IN ADVANCE.**

Outdoor Visitations:

Only residents who do NOT have COVID or symptoms, can have visitors

Limit of 2 visitors at a time

Maximum of 1 visit per day and 2 in a week

Time limits on visits will be determined by staff and availability

Screening

- Pre Screening – will be done by phone less than 24 hours in advance of the visit, we will be using the CDC checklist. Then the determination will be made if the visit can happen or if it will need to be rescheduled
- Upon Arrival – visitors will be rescreened, including a non-contact temperature check

*** If you have traveled to any of the following states under the quarantine mandate we will need you to observe the 14 day quarantine and visit after that is done: Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Puerto Rico, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Utah, Wisconsin, and Wyoming.**

Outdoor Area

- Visitors will not be allowed into the building – even to use the restroom
- Visitors, Residents & Staff are required to wear a mask at all times during the visit
- All participants must maintain 6 feet apart
- Because of social distancing the number of visitors/residents will be limited
- Staff Supervision – Staff will be present during the visit to ensure that safety and protocols are being adhered to
- Visits will be determined by the weather as well, for inclement weather visits will be rescheduled
- Please be on time for visits—if more than 10 minutes late the visit may have to be rescheduled.
